### Customer Challenge

Leading pizza chain test kitchen wanted to improve safety of their cleaner for oven panels  
Wanted to reduce labor time to clean – current product and process required overnight soak

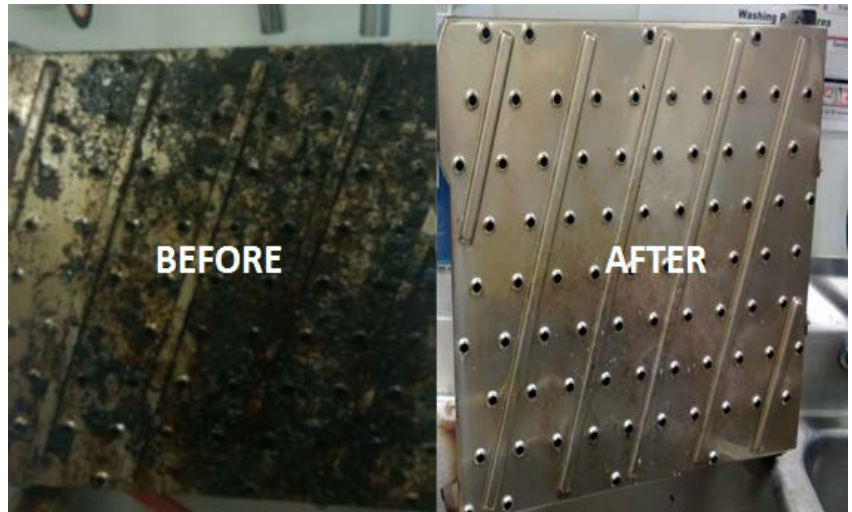
### Solution

eQi chosen due to carbon soil and the need to clean at lower pH for workers and equipment

### The Test

- Removed carbonized panels from pizza oven
- Using eQi RTU prototype cleaner the customer cleaned the panels in 15 minutes with scrubbing; significant time and labor savings vs current method
